**RECEIVER’S SCHEDULE OF PAYMENTS TO BE MADE TO
ELIGIBLE INVESTOR CD CLAIMANTS PURSUANT TO
THE FINAL DISTRIBUTION PLAN**

Receiver Ralph S. Janvey (the “Receiver”) hereby files the Schedule of Payments to Be Made to Eligible Investor CD Claimants¹ Pursuant to the Final Distribution Plan, which schedule is attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** (the “Final Distribution Schedule”). The Final Distribution Schedule reflects payments to be issued in accordance with the October 8, 2025 Order Approving Receiver’s Final Distribution Plan [*see* Doc. 3555] and the November 25, 2025 Order Approving Joint Motion to Amend [*see* Doc. 3562] (together, the “Final Distribution Orders”). Funds distributed under the Final Distribution Plan include funds from the SocGen Settlement² and other Receivership assets. [*See* Doc. 3555 at 4, 8-9.]

¹ The phrase “Investor CD Claimants” includes both Receivership Investor CD Claimants and JL Investor CD Claimants. [*See, e.g.*, Doc. 1877 at 4; Doc. 3555 at 3-4.] The Court has ordered that for purposes of the Final Distribution Plan, the definition of that phrase “is the same definition as in the First through Eleventh Interim Plans.” [*See* Doc. 3555 at 3 n.1.]

² “SocGen Settlement” means the \$114,411,117.32 in funds remaining from the original \$157,000,000.00 received in settlement with Société Générale Private Banking (Suisse) S.A (“SocGen”), after deducting \$4,451,843.57 in allowed expense disbursements and \$38,137,039.11 in Court-awarded attorneys’ fees. [*See* Docs. 3228, 3229 (motion for approval of SocGen Settlement); Doc. 3230 (SocGen Scheduling Order); Doc. 3301 (minute entry concerning June 7, 2023 hearing on SocGen Settlement); Doc. 3304 (Order approving SocGen Settlement); Doc. 3305 (Order approving expenses and attorneys’ fees relating to SocGen Settlement); Docs. 3350, 3351 (Fifth Circuit’s dismissal of R. In preparation for commencing the Final Distribution, and during the first two months of 2026, the Receivership issued payments to eligible claimants totaling more than \$100 million pursuant to Distribution Plans 1-11.

Payments listed on the Final Distribution Schedule will be issued on a rolling basis beginning 14 days after the filing of the Schedule. This process, which will include payments to over 14,000 claim groups, is expected to take several weeks to complete. The Final Distribution Schedule shows that the Receiver intends to make payments totaling \$339,354,750.15 to the owners of the referenced claim numbers.
